

The Earth's Orbit - Who is Right?

Each pair of pupils has something to say about the Earth's orbit. Who is right? Place a tick alongside each correct statement.

Lynn: The shape of the Earth's orbit around the Sun is an ellipse.

Pablo: The shape of the Earth's orbit around the Sun is a circle.

Aaron: The Earth is closest to the Sun in winter and furthest away in summer.

Eve: The Earth is closest to the Sun in summer and furthest away in winter.

Tamsin: The Earth takes $365\frac{1}{4}$ days to revolve around the Sun once.

Clifford: The Earth takes only 28 days to revolve around the Sun once.

Erin: The Earth is the third planet from the Sun.

Jonas: The Earth is the fourth planet from the Sun.

Henry: In summer, the Earth's northern hemisphere is tilted towards the Sun.

Chloe: In summer, the Earth's northern hemisphere is tilted away from the Sun.
